

INSTRUCTIONS

The sling can be used either right or left-handed.

For the right-handed person, hold the unloaded rifle in your left hand and pull the outside strap out with your right hand, making a triangular-shaped loop [Fig. 9]. Put the loop over your head and shoulder [Fig. 8]. This is the FRONT CARRY POSITION [See Fig. 2].

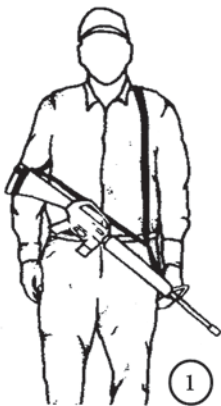
Next, open the FASTENING BUCKLE: [Fig. A] and leave it open as long as you have it in the FRONT CARRY POSITION [Fig. B]. At this point, shoulder your rifle [Fig. 3]. If the butt stock does not clear the strap, check sling adjustment and make larger.

To remove the TACTICAL RESPONSE SLING, first return the rifle to the FRONT CARRY POSITION. Close the FASTENING BUCKLE and lift rifle and sling over head and shoulder.

The TACTICAL RESPONSE SLING can be carried in a muzzledown, hands-free front position [Fig. 1], or a rear hands-free position [Fig. 4&5]. A stop provides a rigid muzzle-level tactical hold [Fig. 2], from this position to a shoulder arms position with no adjustment.

In the back-pack position, [Fig. 6], the weapon may be carried while you are climbing or rappelling [Fig. 7].

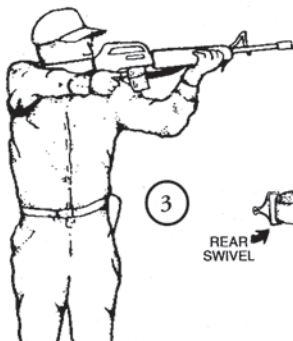

1. Lay your unloaded firearm on a flat surface. Place the sling below the firearm with the buckle end toward the barrel.
2. Remove the post screws from the sling.
3. Pull the single strap back towards the rear swivel. Next, thread the single strap through the rear swivel or boot, then back through the small loop and front swivel. Fold the single strap over the buckle, line up all three holes and replace the post screw through the three holes.
4. Butt Stock Boot: Install with sling on top [Fig. C]. Slip on the butt stock and TIGHTEN SECURELY.

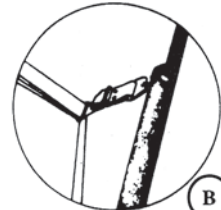
IMPORTANT: Remember to check the post screws periodically, as they can work themselves loose. The use of a thread lock product is recommended; also, black electrical tape on both the screws and the boot.

WARNING! SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS! Firearm safety begins with you!

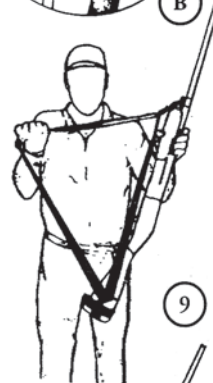
- 1) NEVER RUN, JUMP, CLIMB A TREE or any other activity with a loaded firearm that could result in loss of control or impact of your firearm.
- 2) ALWAYS check sling swivels before entering the field and periodically in the field, to ensure that they are securely tightened.
- 3) RETAIN THIS INSTRUCTION SHEET as well as all instruction sheets relative to the safe operation, maintenance and accessory items of your firearm. Be sure to brief anyone using your firearm as to these instructions and to provide these instructions to anyone purchasing your firearm. *Failure to follow these instructions may result in the sling disconnecting from the firearm. Any such impact could cause accidental discharge possibly resulting in injury or death to yourself or others.*

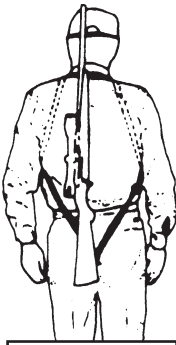
